


NASEO Joins State Groups to Request Comment Extensions on ACE and CAFE Rules

Last month, the Utah Governor's Office of Energy Development and the Baja California Ministry of Economic Development announced an agreement to increase Utah's exports of coal and natural gas to the Mexican state.

The Iowa Energy Office released the Iowa Biomass Action Plan, which outlines steps that the state can take to build on the success of the biofuels industry and take Iowa's bioeconomy to the next level.



DC Mayor Bowser Pledges New Climate Commitments

On September 13, the U.S. Department of Energy and the Environment announced that D.C. Mayor Bowser signed on to new zero-emissions goals at the Global Climate Action Summit last week in an effort to continue shrinking D.C.'s carbon footprint while expanding the city's economy.



Delaware Passes Legislation Enabling C-PACE Program

On August 29, Delaware became the 35th state to pass legislation enabling the creation of a Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy (C-PACE) program. The bill, one of 35 signed by Governor John Carney, authorized the creation of a C-PACE program and called for the state's Sustainable Energy Utility (DESEU) to establish and administer the program.



MEA Helps Hyattsville Police Department Get New EV Wheels

Thanks to a grant from the Maryland Energy Administration, the Hyattsville City Police Department in Maryland has added a Chevrolet Bolt EV and zero electric motorcycle to its police fleet, along with two DC-fast charging stations which can be used by both the police and public.

Energy Planning Underway in Virginia and New Jersey

Virginia and New Jersey are using extensive stakeholder engagement and public input



processes as they develop new comprehensive energy plans, which help guide and build consensus among stakeholders in moving toward a shared goal of meeting future energy needs in a cost-effective and sustainable manner.
